Therefore, between family members there must be a harmonious relationship, full of mutual cooperation, undergoing good cooperation and giving each other affection,

apart from that each family member must also feel calm, happy, cheerful and comfortable in the family (Hasbullah, 2012).

The family is the smallest community in society and country. The family includes father, mother, children and family and also other members who are in the house such as grandparents, aunts, uncles and nephews. The environment is the main fundamental, the base itself can be interpreted as something that is in a fundamental place. From the explanation above, we can mean that children's education first takes place in the family environment and in this case the family has a very big influence on the child's development both physically and mentally as well as his personality. So the roles and responsibilities of the family are not small, because the responsibility is good or bad or the success or failure of family members. The father has a role as the head of the family, and the mother as a minister in the family who must instill various religious values, norms and other regulations in the family such as good and correct behavior, setting a good example and protecting members from all kinds of bad behavior, including educating child's personality. Parents are the most important place for children in the process of developing

their personality. Therefore, the role of both parents is needed to shape the child's personality according to expectations, because it makes it easier for parents to know the child's character and it is easier to protect the child's personality (Samsudin, 2019)

Research methods

As for the definition of literature study is a study that is used in collecting information and data with the help of various materials in the library such as books, e-books, journals, and other publications. Results and Discussion

Personality is the character, nature or characteristics of a person which originates from everything obtained from the environment so that personality is formed, for example the family in childhood, and also the innate person from birth. (Sjarkawi, 2008). The definition of family is as the smallest social unit in society that plays an important role in the development of a child's personality. (Widyashadi, 2019, Poerwadar Minta, 2007). Therefore it can be interpreted that the family environment

influences the development of the child's personality.

Things that influence the development of a child's personality in the form of genetic factors, family factors and environmental factors. Genetic factors are factors that are based on the nature of the parents, the inherited traits can vary, for example, such as being patient, grumpy, having a polite attitude, being bad, stubborn, strong -willed, etc. The family is very influential in the development of a child's personality, there are several domains such as from the embryonic stage, infancy, childhood, and also the adult stage. What is meant by environmental factors, namely such as playmates, neighbors, and also the school environment. Well, sometimes the school environment can directly give color and strong influence, while others only provide certain specificities (Mairefa Galih. 2020, Permatasari, 2015). So, from the explanation above, we can conclude that what is a factor in the formation of a child's personality is related to the attitude of the parents, besides that, the attitude of the family and how the environment in which the child works is also one of the factors in the formation of a child's personality.

Not only the three factors above that can influence the development of a child's personality, but the personality of parents in

education can also be one of the factors that influence the development of a child's personality. Children copy everything their parents do. Hence the saying "the fall of the fruit will not be far from the tree". Mental such as emotions, heart contents and other innate things can affect a person's personality, while physical conditions such as the nervous system, muscle structure and bone conditions also affect a person. So, the personality of the father and mother can be a factor related to the development of the child's personality, therefore mothers and fathers must always educate their children well. The role of parents in their children's education includes: 1) the need for affection, 2) the need for security, 3) the need for self-esteem, 4) the need for a sense of freedom, 5) the need for a sense of success and the need for knowledge. Sumardisuryabrato, 1986).

Parents have a role in every child's personality development, the position of parents in education and upbringing in the family environment greatly determines the child's future, in this case the material for further research is family education. Because parents have a very important role in the future education of their children (Azro, 2003).

Within the family, the father is responsible for the physical and mental development of his children. Father has a duty to provide basic needs such as food, drink, clothing, and others. Fathers are also invited to play an active role in the education of their children. As for mothers, they play a role in the education of their children. The education that mothers teach is basic education for a child which should not be neglected under any circumstances. Whether a mother's upbringing is good or bad for a child greatly influences the maturity and character of her child in the future (Wahib Abdul, 2015).

According to Dangizer quoted by Mairefa Galih (2020), there are 2 main functions when the communication relationship between parents and children occurs, namely the request function and the support function. Demand is a desire for someone to do something or stay away from something, and support is a good response to the fulfillment of a hope.

Regarding the notion of parenting, Suarsini (Adawiah 2017) interprets it as a way for parents to educate them to shape the actions that children will take from time to time. Children accept this behavior both negatively and positively. The form of parents in educating their children will definitely be different for each family and depends on the perspective of

each parent. Mussen (Adnan, 2018) argues that the form of parents in educating is an action taken by parents by implementing various designs to motivate children so that children can achieve their goals. This is done by instilling knowledge, moral values and also the basic things in acting that children must have when they grow up.

Parenting style is very influential on the child's personality. It is important for parents to raise their children properly to develop a good personality. A child's personality is formed by seeing and learning from the people around him. To develop a healthy child's personality, parents must have good manners and manners.

Hurlock argues that there are several factors that can cause this to be the reason for the development of parental actions, the causes for the formation of parental actions in educating include: cited by Nisa (2019:11),

a. The number of descendants. Those who have many offspring usually have various ways of educating their children. As for those with a small number of children will usually behave more extreme. According to Juhardin et al. (2016), currently there are several factors that influence the formation of parenting styles in the family, including:

b. Socioeconomic level

The socio-economic family of the community has a major influence on the survival of family members and those around them, which is based on direct observations in this area. Socio-economic level has a major influence on the behavior of parents of children.

c. Level of education

Education is development in changing the behavior of a person or group towards maturity by carrying out various education that is directly applied. Often people interpret education as an effort made so that a personality that is in accordance with cultural norms and values can be formed.

According to Hastantyo (2010), parents who raise their children have nine personality types that influence the child's personality, namely:

- 1. The morality counselor, overemphasizes detail, study, and morality. Parents advise children to always follow ethics and do positive things (Sjarkhawi, 2006).
- 2. The helper also prioritizes the needs of the child, ignoring the consequences of the child's actions. In any situation, parents are always the ones who help their children (Sjarkhawi, 2006).

- 3. Make rules so that you want to always work with children, help with existing tasks and improve situations that occur.
- 4. Leadership attitude, namely always wanting to interact emotionally with children for all situations and looking for the best way out together, so that the child becomes more open and cooperative to share his problems with his parents (Sunarty, 2015). Each parent has the same dream, namely the success of their child, whatever parents do to make their child's dream come true (Sajarkhawi, 2006).
- Observers who are always looking for a holistic perspective try to emphasize the objectivity and perspective of parents.
- Worrying, namely checking, reviewing and always wondering, doubting and imagining the worst until the child really understands it.
- Cheerful , always choose a casual demeanor.
- 8. Guarding, usually replacing and tending to it, yelling at the child, then saving it from future harm.
- 9. Calm, under the influence of his personality that always avoids conflict.

According to Mairefa Galih (2020), the actions in forming a child's personality, for

example, are the attitudes adopted by mothers and fathers to respond to the behavior of their children, this is a model of behavior that will be embedded in children in the future. An attitude that is in line with the Shari'a and parents' moral standards makes the religious life of the child's soul, then becomes part of his personality. Most importantly, fathers and mothers are the only first role models for their children in terms of personality development, and children are subconsciously influenced by them, so these are the two parents as role models for both, at a theoretical and practical level. Before fathers and mothers teach religious and moral and emotional values to their children, they must first practice them themselves.

Results From the Role of Parents Against Children's Personality

Parents who educate children by teaching religious values, manners, exemplary, honesty and also good manners will produce better children's personalities such as being religious, polite, honest, helpful, compassionate and patient. Well, on the other hand, if parents don't teach good things to their children, it will also produce bad children's personalities, for example, such as stubborn, impolite, liars, naughty, and others. Therefore something the

behavior of parents that they show and apply to children will be a determinant of how the child's personality in the future.
