The reason our group chose this is because we see that nowadays there is a lot of violence, starting from physical violence, psychological violence, and bullying. In addition, there is a lot of news that bullying in Indonesia is very high starting from high school 18.75%, junior high school 25% and elementary school also 25%. It can be seen from the data on bullying cases in elementary schools that there are 480 cases of bullying that increase from year to year such as in 2020 there were 119 cases, in 2021 there was a decrease and only 17 cases, and in 2022 there was an increase in cases up to 226 cases ranging from physical, psychological violence and including bullying. in 2023 there were 64 complaints of cases, until there was a case in June that made an elementary school child die due to bullying. from these data it is questionable how the role of civic education teachers is about fostering social awareness for students in elementary school. Many reasons that make elementary school children start bullying start from trends seen from social media and the environment around where live. it makes children thev start discriminating against their friends who do not match them starting from their physique, nature, and different economies.

The results of the interviews we conducted with teachers at SD Negeri 060829 said "that there have been cases of bullying in elementary schools, for example: The problem of mocking parents' names and fighting between friends about mocking each other and the bullying cases can still be reprimanded and anticipated, that is why it is important for schools and parents to educate children about the importance of respecting and supporting each other, we can see that if the lack of role from parents makes children misbehave, therefore support is needed from teachers in raising awareness in respecting differences.

This school also studies PPKN subjects because this study can help children to understand national values such as national unity and ordinary small things such as mutual cooperation and care for the environment and here. And in the environment of elementary school children, there are still frequent cases of fighting

between friends and the reason is usually because there are friends who mock their parents' names and bully their friends. However, there are ways that teachers overcome these problems, we break up, reprimand and advise both parties of students who fight to follow up so that the two students forgive each other and do not do the same thing again. And the role played by teachers in shaping the social awareness of elementary school children is that a teacher must be able to unite the various traits and characters of these different children in order to develop children's social attitudes properly. So that children can socialize with their peers and people who are in the school environment well."

The teacher also provides guidance and understanding about the importance of good communication, having empathy and learning to understand differences, and tells them that violence is not the way to solve this, but to speak calmly and respect each other.
