This type of research is qualitative research, namely analyzing the form of description, not in the form of numbers or coefficients regarding the relationship between variables. The data source in this research is the novel Rain by Tere Live, consisting of 315 things. Length 21 cm, width 34 cm, published by Gramedia main library Jakarta 2016. The data collection technique for this research is note-reading technique, considering that the object of study in this research is a text, namely the novel Rain by Tere Liye. The data analysis used in this research is content analysis or scientific methods for studying and drawing conclusions by utilizing text. RESEARCH RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Research result

1. Intrinsic Elements of the Novel Rain by Tere Liye

Intrinsic elements include theme, plot, setting, characters and characterization, point of view, language style, and message. In detail it can be described as follows:

a. Theme

Theme is the core or basic idea of a story. From this basic idea, the story is then built by the writer using intrinsic elements, such as plot, characterization and setting. Theme in the novel Rain by Tere Liye. The major theme is "Love between men and women separated by distance and time". The minor themes are the themes of mutual help, friendship and affection.

d. Characterization

Characterization is a description of a character's character.
